CODES ENFORCEMENT – Mayor Nixon read Mr. Geary's report.

PARKS & RECREATION – Alderman Powell mentioned two young men for their accomplishments. Alderman Orr's grandson, Hudson Randall, pitcher for Florida and Carl Cantrell's grandson, Dakota Cantrell, winner of a fishing tournament. Ms. Derryberry is working on a music and an art class for the seniors. The Landscaping Committee is doing work around town. They are doing a great job.

OLD BUSINESS



CITIZENS HEARING -- NONE


CALENDAR OF EVENTS - July 4th activities
